Erindale Nursery School (ENS) operates from September to June, with breaks at Christmas and March Break in line with the Peel District School Board. ENS presently operates a morning preschool (age 2 ½ to 4) and afternoon kindergarden (age 4 to 5) program up to five days a week. Activities and meetings are also held occasionally during the evenings.

Erindale Nursery School seeks an energetic, qualified and experienced E.C.E. Teacher/Supervisor to plan and teach all programs, supervise staff, liaise with the volunteer parent board and ensure all the licensing requirements of the school are maintained. Position will commence part-time in Spring 2012 and full time come September 2012.

- Be a professional, positive team player, maintaining an on going positive relationship with other staff members and parents
- Have the ability to assist in providing an academically balanced and creative program
- Posses strong communication skills, both verbal and written; with the ability to relay relevant information and feedback to parents, staff and children
- Have the ability to take initiative and follow through on tasks
- Have good understanding of the Day Nurseries Act and other relevant legislative and health and safety requirements related to a nursery school environment
- Be flexible, enthusiastic with the ability to respond to the children's various needs and the on-going changes that occur within a childcare environment

Pre-Requisite Requirements:

All candidates must:

- Hold an Early Childhood Education Diploma at an accredited University or College,
- Be registered with the College of Early Childhood Education and in good standing,
- Hold a current CPR/First Aid Certificate,
- Have a minimum two (2) years experience as an early childhood educator in a licensed early childhood program including supervisory or leadership experience,
- Have experience working with a parent/volunteer Board of Directors,
- Pass a satisfactory Criminal Records Check,
- Posses a current health assessment, including TB test, up to date immunizations,
- Be legally allowed to work in Canada.
