

Mississauga Halton Local Health Integration Network Delegations on Integration Opportunities / Service Improvements

The Mississauga Halton Local Health Integration Network (LHIN) is in the early stages of developing its first Integrated Health Service Plan (IHSP).

The Mississauga Halton LHIN believes that members of the public and service providers should be part of a broad-based discussion of opportunities to improve the local health services system. As part of our engagement strategy, we invite your written comments on integration opportunities in our community.

If you have comments or suggestions that would assist in the development of the first IHSP we would like to hear from you. Delegations made in early May, will be considered for the Draft IHSP. Delegations will be received on an ongoing basis in conjunction with regular Board Meetings.

Guidelines for Delegations:

- Each delegation will have the opportunity to make a 15-minute presentation to the IHSP Steering Committee of the Mississauga Halton LHIN in a public forum.
- The presentation will be followed by a 5 minute question and answer period.
- An LCD projector will be available if required.
- An electronic version of the presentation must be provided to the LHIN (CD or email) along with 10 copies of the presentation materials
- The presentation should include:
 - Name of network/organization/individual(s), names and titles of individual(s) presenting, address, phone, e-mail, date.
 - Response to one or more of the following issues:
 - Current integration initiatives your organization/group is part of
 - Planned integration initiatives
 - Other/new integration opportunities that should be explored
 - In describing integration opportunities, please highlight the following:
 - Specific nature of the opportunity
 - Population(s) served
 - Collaborations and partners involved and community linkages
 - Benefits of the opportunity
 - Impact (high/medium/low)
 - Effectiveness (how do you know it will work?)
 - Implementation of the opportunity:

- Level of effort (high/medium/low)
- Timing (< 1 year, 1-3 years, 4+ years)
- Level of provider and public readiness for the opportunity
- Enablers that will facilitate implementation
- Barriers/challenges/risks
- Financial impacts
