

CHAP Workers promote active living for individuals with developmental disabilities including autism and/or physical disabilities in the individual's home and in the community while providing parent relief. Workers registered on the CHAP Worker Bank are connected with families looking for support.

Note: Workers on the registry are self-employed and not employees of the CHAP/CDRCP Program.

### Key Responsibilities:

- Provide safe, stimulating and recreational support both in the home and in the community
- Provide care and supervision according to the individuals needs
- Provide respite/support services as requested by the parent/guardian
- Punctual, reliable and respectful of the family
- Network with community groups, facilitate inclusion and act as a positive role model
- Communicate with the CHAP/CDRCP Program Facilitator

### Requirements:

- Ability and willingness to work with persons with disabilities
- Experience providing care and support to persons with disabilities is an asset
- Effective communication skills with both verbal and non-verbal populations
- Commitment to providing quality life experiences in home and in the community
- Police Criminal Reference Check
- Full day CHAP Orientation Session
- First Aid and CPR is an asset

- Variable hours (days, evening, weekends, overnights, relief, summer)
- Part-time hourly (possibility of additional hours)
