

Passport

Passport is an initiative designed to enhance community participation supports for individuals who have a developmental disability. It is designed for young people who are preparing to leave or have left high school, and are seeking community participation supports. This initiative provides funding for community partnerships, suited for a range of functional abilities. Through this initiative, participants will be exposed to a variety of experiences that focus on post-secondary school activities and the personal development that each individual needs to achieve his/her goals for living as an adult in the community.

Individuals and families have the option of receiving Passport funding directly and making their own arrangements to purchase supports and services or choosing to access services through community-based agencies.

How to Apply: To apply for Passport, individuals and their families need to go through the intake process of Developmental Services Ontario.
