The agency you contact will assist you in completing a consumer request profile and then the profile is added to the waiting list for residential services. When a vacancy becomes available, an inter-agency committee of service providers reviews the waiting list to determine who meets the criteria for the vacancy and is most in need of the residential placement. Being on the wait list is the only way to access developmental residential services.

Alternatively, a new initiative called The Innovative Residential Model Initiative gives adults with a developmental disability and their families the opportunity to propose individually tailored residential services concerning where and how they live. Working together, individuals, their families and service providers can develop proposals for housing options that are best suited to their personal needs, wants and dreams (for example, a separate suite in a home, a co-ownership arrangement, etc.)

If you are interested in residential services for people with developmental disabilities, you need to go through Developmental Services Ontario before you can access the services of any of agencies that provide this service in Peel.
