

College Vocational Program

The College Vocational Program is specifically for students with learning difficulties, and is designed to assist the student's development in academic skills, as well as skills for both independent living and working. The ultimate goal is preparation for employment. Through classroom learning and work experience, the student has opportunities to gain life and vocational skills.

The subjects are designed to enable the student to progress in language and mathematics, as well as to gain knowledge and skills for living and working. Supervised work training experiences are the core of the student's program.

Admission Requirements:

- Ontario Secondary School Certificate with 14 credits (7 compulsory) or Ontario Secondary School Diploma with credits at the Workplace (W) or modified College Preparation (C) level or Mature Student Status (age 19 or older).

Applicant Selection:

- Comprehensive skills at Grade 6 level as evidenced by standardized testing. The CAAT C test is administered by Seneca College.
- Minimum age is 17 years for OSSC or OSSD Graduates.

George Brown- Toronto, ON

- One year job-readiness program
- Designed to meet the unique educational and vocational needs of people who may not normally consider or qualify for entry into a traditional post-secondary program.
- Individualized, supportive program, that helps students develop academic, practical and social skills

- In addition, students participate in career planning, communication and life skills training and a work experience placement.

Admission Requirements:

- Ontario Secondary School Certificate with 14 credits (7 compulsory) or Ontario Secondary School Diploma with credits at the Workplace (W) or modified College Preparation (C) level or Mature Student Status (age 19 or older).
- Attend interview

Fees: \$ 2,824.00 per year. Students enrolled in this program are eligible for loans and grants.
