What is Service Coordination?

Service Coordination is provided by a community service organization and provides information, makes referrals for individuals and families to other community programs, and assists families to access social service programs. Assistance is provided to families to provide support and advocacy.

The following agencies provide Service Coordination:

Brampton Caledon Community Living

Brampton Caledon Community Living supports people with a developmental disability, in partnership with their families and the community, to lead enriched and meaningful lives. For individuals aged 18+, service coordinators provide information, make referrals for individuals and families to community programs, and assist families to access social service assistance.

Community Living Mississauga

Support is provided to individuals of all ages who live with their families in the community. Service Coordinators assist individuals and their families in obtaining necessary supports, resources and services that are required to meet their needs. Assistance is provided in the areas of funding applications, school placement issues, planning for seasonal programs, school to work/day alternative transitions and the development of a long-term plan.

Kerry's Place

Community Services provides consultation and support to individuals, families, schools and other agencies regarding the issues surrounding the Pervasive Developmental Disorder Spectrum. Consultation and teaching focuses on behavioural supports, communication strategies, life and social skills, long term planning and school advocacy.
